

Construction

Decorations –

We will decorate with Caution tape, little construction signs, tiny little orange cones, “rocks” and play tools, little construction vehicles - \$35.00 rental/installation fee

Balloons –

11 inch qualitex balloons in any color you you wish or yellow and black –12.00 per dozen.

Mylars- from stars to flowers, suns, butterflies- priced upon request (\$3.00-\$10.00 each)

Craft ideas -

Decorating little construction helmets – Each helmet will have a small label for the front of the construction hat that has your child’s name and age – i.e. “Jake’s Construction Company – 4 years in the Biz”. Kids decorate helmets with stickers and sharpee pens.

Hats come in two styles –

thin plastic - \$2.00 each

Hard thick plastic (dress up quality) - \$4.00 each

Wooden structures – Using wood blocks in a variety of sizes and shapes, kids make fun wooden objects from houses to chairs to tables or whatever your child’s imagination suggests - \$2.50 each

Chinese food container houses – using little containers as a form kids can design their own homes - \$3.00 each

Group Town – using a variety of supplies we can build a town, with kids creating whatever they would like to add to the town (shops, cars, houses, airport, whatever) the creations would be added to a large foam core street scene – kids can play with the set up and later take their art contribution home with them - \$2.50 each

Little mini construction zones – each kid can create their own site and make little trucks that can drive using a tiny magnet stick – sand and other fun construction materials make for fun driving - \$3.00 each

Games -

Foreman Says – the leader plays the foreman and leads the others in a “workday” – i.e. – Foreman says – “dig with your shovel”, etc. but if he doesn’t say “foreman says” then don’t do it.

Hammer Time - this is great if you have some space. The children line up on one side of the room and try to get to the other without being tagged by the blow up hammer. if they are, they have to freeze until someone tags them and sets them free.

Don’t Knock it Down – kids sit in a circle and take turns placing small wooden blocks in a pile, the object of the game is to get rid of all of your wooden blocks, but if you knock down the pile you have to take all the blocks.

Cement Mixer – Each child stands in a hula hoop on the ground. They are each a supply – sand, water, dirt. The foreman yells out one of the supplies – anyone who is that supply jumps out of their hoops and tries to find a new hoop before the foreman can take theirs. If the foreman calls out “cement mixer” everyone must find a new hoop. Whomever is left gets to call out the new supply.

Brick by Brick relay – Using oversized bricks two teams compete to complete their “contract” – they must run through an obstacle course with a brick, place it on the sight to build a wall. The first group to complete their contract wins.
