

DINO PARTY

We could start out with some dino tattoos until all the kids got there

Decorations

We set up a little "archeologist base camp tent" with a fake fire; decorate with a Jurassic jungle of shimmering trees, and rainbow streamers. I can then gather everyone at varying times at "base camp" for instructions, for songs, for stories, etc. - Cost for all the set up and rental - \$35.00

Balloons

Standard balloons - \$12.00 per dozen (in tropical colors)

Mylar balloons -

Amazingly huge Mylar sun balloon - \$7.50

CRAFT

We would get the kids rolling with our exploding volcanoes - each child makes their own mini volcano using triangle forms, play dough, and green tissue paper for trees. We then make the volcanoes explode with baking soda "snow" and "fire juice" vinegar. - Cost - \$4.00 per child

Decorating Pith helmets – plastic - \$1.50 each/ Straw - \$4.00

We make our own binoculars that could be decorated with stickers, markers, etc. then they could wear them for the treasure hunt. - \$2.00 per kit

Dino masks - using half masks kids can decorate with feathers, fur, sparkles, etc. to make a dino of their dreams - \$2.00 per kit

Dino Puppets- using Styrofoam balls and an assortment of fun materials, kids can make their own dino puppet - \$3.00 each

GAMES

The tar pit game. Kids have to get across the tar pit without getting caught by the mean T-rex. (Lots of running and squealing)

Steal the egg - kids try to sneak up and steal the baby dino egg before the dino turns around and catches them

Floating islands - hula-hoops go on the ground. I play the guitar, when the music plays the kids can be anywhere but in the hoops, when the music stops they must hop into one of the hoops, we keep taking away hoops until there is only one hoop left.

Catch a dino - using the hoops the kids become dino's and my assistant and I are the trappers. Kids run around while we try to "trap" them. If we catch them they must freeze until someone tags them, then they can run free again.

TREASURE HUNT

Following the trail of dino tracks that are hidden with clues the kids end up at an archeological dig sight, where they can dig up little dino eggs that have real dino's inside (plastic of course) \$2.50 per child

PINATA

Pull string type - each child takes a turn pulling a streamer, one opens the bottom - \$25.00 for rental of piñata with dino front

Candy baggies can be provided – these are personalized with the birthday child's name - \$2.50 each (you just tell us what types of candy you want)

Mini M&M tubes with personalized themed label - \$2.00 each

Personalized Chocolate bars - \$2.00 each
