

Doggy Party

Decor

stars, streamers, blue sparkle glitter clouds, the moon to howl at, paw prints that lead from the front of the house to the entry way, numerous stand up cut outs of doggies, and even a doghouse for the kids to crawl through - \$45.00 rental/installation

Balloons

Standard 11 inch qualitetex balloons - \$12.00 per dozen

Dalmation balloons - \$14.00 per dozen

Mylar balloons - priced upon request - between \$3.00 - \$12.00 each

Activities

Face Painting and Doggy Ears - you can't be a doggy without a spot or two, and everyone needs ears to make the look complete - \$3.50 per child (or each child can be given a "doggy baseball cap" - \$4.00 each)

Once we have everyone decked out we go to pet obedience school where I "train" the kids. I teach them very simple hand signals for "stay", "roll over", "beg", "shake hands", etc. Each one is rewarded with a treat for doing well. (they love this - it sort of becomes a game of Simon Says once they learn the hand commands). Each puppy is given a certificate of achievement from "Barkley" Academy.

A Howling/Barking contest follows - if you like we can give each child a little trophy (tiniest bark, loudest bark, fiercest bark, cutest bark, quietest bark, etc.) filled with baby M&M's for \$2.50 per child

Then it's through the doggy obstacle course, where doggies have to jump, climb, crawl, roll, and even scoop a little poop (foam balls).

If kids are so inclined we can have a pet show, where those who feel comfortable can come up and do a little dog trick.

We must sing "Oh I Wanna Be a Dog" and "How Much is That Doggy in the Window" along with "Bingo" and others

Games

Doggy hide and seek - we hide a doggy bone and all the little ones must find it. Whoever finds it, gets to hide it the next time.

Doggy Doggy where's my bone - someone plays the doggy with a dog bone...another doggy steals it, the doggy tries to guess who.

Roll over - using balloons the doggies must use their noses to roll the balloon to the end of the room.

The doggies tail - there are two versions of this...In one, one child has the tail and everyone tries to snatch it by chasing them, and then they become the dog...or in another version the kids hold onto each other and the head tries to catch the tail.

Fetch - we place little "doggy bones" (large pretzel sticks) and the doggies must go retrieve it with their mouth. The kids love this. (\$6.00 to cover cost of pretzels)

Dog Catcher - I'm the dog catcher and the kids are the dogs - I chase them with my magic dog catching hoop (hula hoop) if they get caught they have to freeze...however they can be released by 4 of their furry friends.

Crafts

(we will bring a wonderful assortment of creative, inspiring supplies - at Sophie's Stress Free Soirees we do not use "kits" - instead we bring oodles and oodles of stuff that lights the imagination and allows kids to think outside the box)

Decorating dog collars - \$3.00 each

Decorating doggy bowls - \$3.50 each

Stuffed doggies... little "socks" that the kids can make into their own animal - \$3.00 each

Take a picture of the kids and put it in a little doghouse frame with a magnet on the back. The kids use little dog biscuits, etc. to decorate- \$3.00 each

Pinata (unfilled)

we can fill your piñata with whatever kind of treats that you would like – our suggestion is to fill them with personalized candy “baggies” (your child’s name on the little label – thanks for coming to ...’s party) – candy baggies can contain anything you want, however we usually provide a \$2.50 bag that includes chocolate coins, candy ring pop, candy bracelet, candy necklace, kisses, and starbursts

Whack’em piñatas – unfilled \$15.00 and up – depending upon size and complexity – priced upon request (we have some very high end companies that can make 3 foot piñatas – they are pricey, but they are beautiful) – you specify what type you would like.

Pull string – \$20.00 – kids pull on streamers to release the hidden trap door – doggy artwork on the front (this is great for children up to 6 years of age)

Goodie Bags

All goodie bags are personalized and can either be done with your child’s name only (ie – thank you for coming to ...’s party) or with your party guest’s names...(we will need those names a week before the party)

Cute little cellophane bags – \$1.00 each

Glossy paper lunch bags – \$1.25 each

Glossy or Matte Handle bags – \$1.75 each (good for larger goodies)

Hand Sewn Gossamer/fabric bags – \$2.50

Cellophane wrapped dog bowl, personalized with child’s name – \$3.50 each

Other ideas may come up given the goodies chosen...such as wrapped goodies. (priced upon request)
